

URGENT CALL FROM APELDOORN - THE NETHERLANDS - TO UNITED NATIONS CLIMATE CONFERENCE, COP26 - GLASGOW

Call from participants* united in the CLIMATE LESSON program
meeting on Tuesday, 12th October 2021.

We urgently call for implementation of the Paris Agreement 2015 for present and future generations. According to this first, unique, universal legally binding global climate treaty by 195 Nations.

We see time pass without sufficient results and concern, doubt and lack of confidence in timely implementation.

The future of people, nature and the planet is threatened. Meanwhile attention is shifting to nation states and self-interest. Human rights are not respected and more strongly, totally and cruelly denied. Economic and geopolitical conflicts, the struggle for global power, blinds nations to what is urgent for the world's population: working together for a livable planet.

After the Paris Agreement your duty in Glasgow:

Keep the average temperature rise on earth below 2 degrees Celsius, limit it to 1.5 degrees - Reduce greenhouse gas emissions and harmful substances - Adjust the food production - Make 100 billion dollar available each year for poorer countries.

We call for:

- Struggle against inequality, poverty and hunger.
- Broad approach to reduce biodiversity loss.
- Sustainable food production and the interests of small farmers.
- Circular economic production and consumption.

We call for human rights, mutual respect, opportunities and a safe future for everyone.
